The criteria for evaluating the assessment items (indicators) are: Excellent (5), Good (4), Satisfactory (3), Fair (2), and Needs Improvement (1).

6. Evaluation: The results of the internal performance evaluation of the Board of Directors for 2024 were presented to the 13th meeting of the 24th Board of Directors of the Company held on March 5, 2025.

The results of the evaluation are summarized below:

The Board's performance indicators consist of five major aspects and a total of 45 indicators.
